What is the ISS?

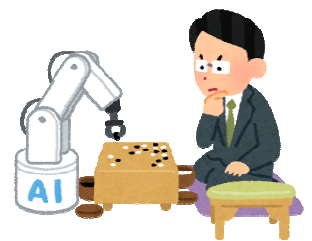
