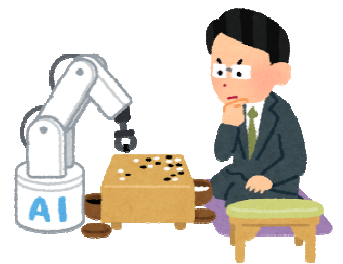
What is the International Summer Symposium(ISS)?
