



2_{missions} FY 2017 Disaster Investigation

In response to the occurrence of disasters in and out of the country, JSCE establishes headquarters to form and send out investigation missions, and to publish academic and technical analysis as well as advice on disaster prevention.

International assignments have been made 36 times between 1999 and 2017, sending 386 researchers and engineers. At the 2017 Kumamoto Earthquake, various committees sent their missions including one directed by the JSCE president. In total 52 JSCE members were also dispatched for the massive rain disaster in Northern Kyusyu in 2017.

November 18th is designated as "the Civil Engineering Day" by JSCE. The characters " $\pm \, \pi$ " which denote "civil engineering" can be decomposed into four characters " $+ - + \Lambda$ " or numbers eleven & eighteen which can be read as November 18th. Coincidentally JSCE was established on the day in 1879.

JSCE holds ceremonies and exhibitions every year. In 2017, a symposium was held with a panel discussion and movie exhibition on Dr. Koi Furuich, the first president of the society. "The Civil Engineering Exhibition 2017— To find future Tokyo, wander around infrastructures" was also held in Tokyo to exhibit historical archives that include documents, drawings, and pictures.

Credentials

JSCE established the Civil Engineering Credentials in 2001. It has four categories for civil engineers, and JSCE conducts the review and registration. The credential is now listed in the 47 domains of MLIT's requirements.

We have 13,961 registered engineers as of 2018, and they are required to report the history of their continuing education for every five-year credential renewal.
